Roles and Responsibilities

- Prepare steel through abrasive blasting (Steel grit, Garnet and Black Beauty are common blast media used)
- Read and interpret drawings
- Masking and protecting surfaces as necessary
- Operate abrasive blast equipment efficiently and safely
- Material handling
- Basic troubleshooting and maintenance of equipment
- Basic knowledge of hand tools for use when grinding, cutting material, trimming, sanding, lining removals, etc.
- Perform quality assurance, track and record data
- Cross-train in other departments to learn various applications (Industrial Coatings & Rubber Lining applications)

Qualifications and Educational Requirements

- A minimum of 3 years Abrasive blasting experience is required
